



SKATE CANADA COACH ANNUAL RECOGNITION AWARDS

BASIC CATEGORIES – Club, Competitive or Volunteer

1. The coach must be a 2009-2010 registered Skate Canada certified coach in good standing.
2. The coach must be appropriately NCCP certified at the level for which the award is being given.
3. The coach must have demonstrated exemplary professional behaviour on a consistent basis in accordance with the Skate Canada Code of Ethics and accepted rules of conduct and have demonstrated notable volunteer service in order to qualify for nomination in any of the categories.
4. The coach can be recognized for outstanding achievement in any one of the three categories during the past skating year as follows:

a) Club

For leadership, creativity, organization and/or co-operation at the club level in terms of the development of skating, new and/or innovation programs, increased membership, club management, volunteer service at club level.

b) Competitive

For coaching a competitive skater(s) or team(s) in Singles, Pairs, Dance or Synchronized Skating who has/have accomplished a significant achievement.

c) Volunteer

For the volunteer contribution of service within the skating community at any level, eg. Work on a committee or skating event.
